

Open lecture on How to avoid EQE traps in paper D.

The EQE may be tough also for those candidates who have brilliantly graduated from the University, and are capable of doing the work of patent attorney.

Passing the exam requires not only a theoretical preparation on the EPC, but also a specific training to the exam.

The lecture of Stephane Speich aims at focussing the attention on those points which at the EQE may be most problematic, teaching how to avoid some of the typical mistakes which can be done during your preparation before the exam and at the exam.

30% of the candidates taking the EQE end up with marks comprised between 35 and 45 marks, including many who are well prepared. The problem for the well prepared people is a lack of methodology, they should:

- Develop and test their reading and writing speed
- Test how to find the information quickly

This course will try to help the candidates to the EQE paper D to improve their pass rate (50 marks).

Stephane Speich is an experienced European Patent Attorney from Luxemburg and author of a well-known commentary on the EPC.
